Here we are, we are all moved in and operating out of our shiny new building! We couldn't have done it without each of our generous donors. To show off our hard work, and your generosity, we have scheduled our public open house for Sunday, October 16, from 3 to 5 pm. All are welcome to come out and see our new facility and meet a few animals awaiting homes. With any luck, you may even fill out an adoption application for one of those animals!

What can you expect at our open house? First, you will be greeted by Aberdeen Area Humane Society Staff and our Board of Directors. You will then get a guided tour around the building. We are certain you will be impressed with the roughly 7,000 sq. foot layout which is optimized for traffic flow and operational efficiency.

You'll check out the dog kennels with indoor and outdoor access which provide exercise space, fresh air and a less stressful environment.

You won't miss our expanded and open cat sanctuary which allows cats more area to play, roam, and interact with adopters.

You'll tour the medical rooms which provide the needed space for our volunteer veterinarians to care for our animals. You'll also learn about our HVAC system and isolation areas for dogs and cats which help to prevent the spread of illness to adoptable animals.

Finally, you'll pass by our office, meet and greet rooms and conference rooms. All of which allow more people to spend more time interacting and meeting animals, volunteering, and learning about responsible pet ownership!

**Microchip Event** 

Microchips provide permanent identification for your pet, so they can be easily found if they get lost. A microchip is about the size of a grain of rice and is inserted underneath the skin, quickly and easily. Unlike collars and ID tags, they can never break or fall-off. They work by receiving a radio signal from a scanner and transmitting the pet identification number back to the scanner. With the chip identification number in hand, the vital contact information is only a phone call away. In celebration of our open house, we will be offering microchip services at a discounted rate of \$25 per animal from October 9-October 23! Call 605-226-1200 to schedule your appointment!
